Like the weather, everyone talks about "ecology," but until recently no one did much about it ... Way back when "ecology" was an unknown word in the dictionary, Walt Disney was trying to tell us something ... You remember, one of his first cartoon films was "Bambi," which dealt with the reckless killing of animal life and the despoiling of timber land. His nature films like "Seal Island," "Beaver Valley," the "African Lion" and other Academy Award films, showed Walt's endless preoccupation with our environment and the animal species ... So, it's not surprising in this new Disney World acres have been set aside as a wildlife sanctuary to be kept untouched and unchanged for the generations to come --

(INTO: ECOLOGY FILM)

ECOLOGY FILM

BOB (V.O.)

-- a wilderness as it has been

since almost the dawn of time. Here is a rare and special kind of civilization

WINSTON HIBLER (V.O.

Within the boundaries of the Walt
Disney World there is another
world... a secluded water wilderness
encompassing more than seven
thousand acres.

The lush setting offers a sanctuary for the many forms of animal life.

Often seen here is the bobcat. This is one of our rarest species —

the Florida panther. Here too is the home of the black bear... the red fox... his smaller first cousin, the grey fox... the shy white-tailed deer... the armor plated armadillo... and several varieties of squirrel.

This is the grey squirrel. The raccoon is found here in great numbers. This is the spotted skunk.

(MORE)

WINSTON HIBLER (V.O. CONT'D)

In a multitude of birds, perhaps
the most familiar is the flamingo,
the status symbol of Florida's
water fowl. In his graceful flight
the flamingo is often joined by the
common egret. The great blue heron
also lives here.

This is the state-protected snowy egret. The little grebe finds time for a cooling bath.

The mud swallows take their plunge on the wing... satisfied with a splash and a sprinkle.

The energetic coot, in a unique adaptation to his environment, prefers to dip below the surface... using his wings as paddles.

The anhinga, or snakebird, is also a submarine waterfowl. The snakebird's wings become so saturated he must literally hang them out to dry.

The cormorant has the same problem, and follows the same technique.

WINSTON HIBLER (V.O. CONT'D)

For the hungry birds, there is plenty of good hunting here. The purple gallinule feeds on snails which he finds under lily pads...

While the spoonbill must dredge up a meal by running his curved beak along the bottom.

A remnant of the prehistoric past, the alligator is undisputed monarch of this water-world...

To this rollicking family of otters, the alligator's prior claim on this pond is a matter of small concern.

They can swim rings around the 'gator and go out of their way to prove it.

Although the otters are permitted to intrude in the alligator's kingdom, it is a privilege that will never be granted to man. For in this wildlife sanctuary nature's creatures will always be given the protection that is their due, as the first inhabitants of the Walt Disney World.
