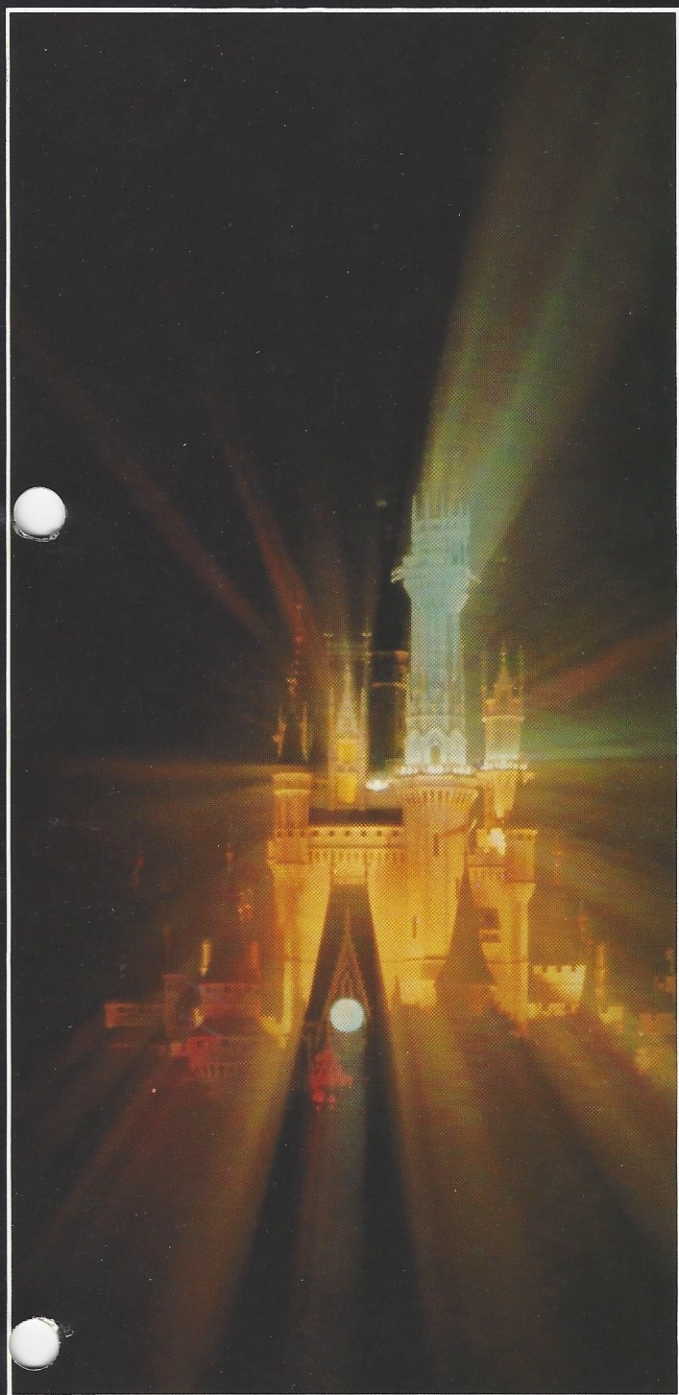

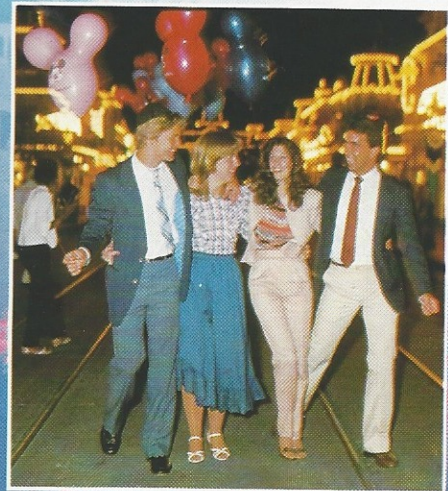
**Be the first class to enjoy the newest wonder of the World: Epcot Center!**

Count down to Grad Nite '83 with a preparty celebration in Tomorrowland (optional). Blast-Off participants enjoy dinner and exclusive use of all Tomorrowland attractions. Two parties are being held this year: Friday, May 6 and Friday, May 13.

## **Start Planning Now**

Since Grad Nite is such a spectacular affair, your plans should begin now. As soon as your class decides to attend, an adult Grad Nite Coordinator must be appointed. This Coordinator plans all details for your school's participation and acts as official correspondent with the Walt Disney World Grad Nite office. He or she oversees the sale of tickets as well.

Grad Nite is a popular event and attendance is limited, so tickets are sold only in advance. They're available for \$13 per stu-

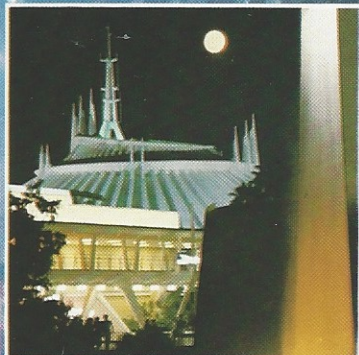
dent. Each ticket includes all entertainment, unlimited use of the Magic Kingdom attractions, plus your keepsake photograph. It does not cover food, beverages or transportation to and from Grad Nite. An additional \$7.50 per student to attend Blast-Off allows you to begin your super evening at 7:30 p.m. in Tomorrowland. Chaperone tickets to Blast-Off are \$5.25.

To fully enjoy your graduation outing, the second day Epcot Center option is an additional \$11 per student. Chaperones are free.

Your Coordinator should handle your school's travel arrangements through a travel agent, airline or bus company in your community.

For everyone's safety and convenience, all Grad Nite guests must arrive via chartered or school bus. Student-driven vehicles will not be admitted to the Walt Disney World property for Blast-Off parties or Grad Nite.

Each school must appoint chaperones to be on hand during Grad Nite to take care of any special situations and requests. Only one chaperone per 10 students will be permitted to attend. Chaperones, who may be either parents or faculty members, will receive complimentary Grad Nite tickets. For more details and reservations, contact the Walt Disney World Grad Nite Office soon. # Dress Up and Celebrate!

Grad Nite is a lot like your prom — a chance to dress up and look as festive as you feel. To help you choose just the right outfit, there are some guidelines. In order to be fair to all who attend, a conscious effort by everyone to enforce this dress code would be appreciated.

## Ladies

Semiformal short or long party dresses, coordinated suits (pants or skirt outfits), with appropriate dress shoes or dress sandals (the lower the heel the more comfortable).

## Gentlemen

Dress shirt with dress slacks and tie (traditional or bow). Suits, sportcoats and tuxedos are optional. Dress shoes or boots.

## Please leave these at home

Halter tops, midriffs, jeans, shorts, turtlenecks, tank tops, golf or T-shirts, open collars, flip-flops, tennis shoes. Casual pants with top, or skirt with blouse are not appropriate for this occasion.
