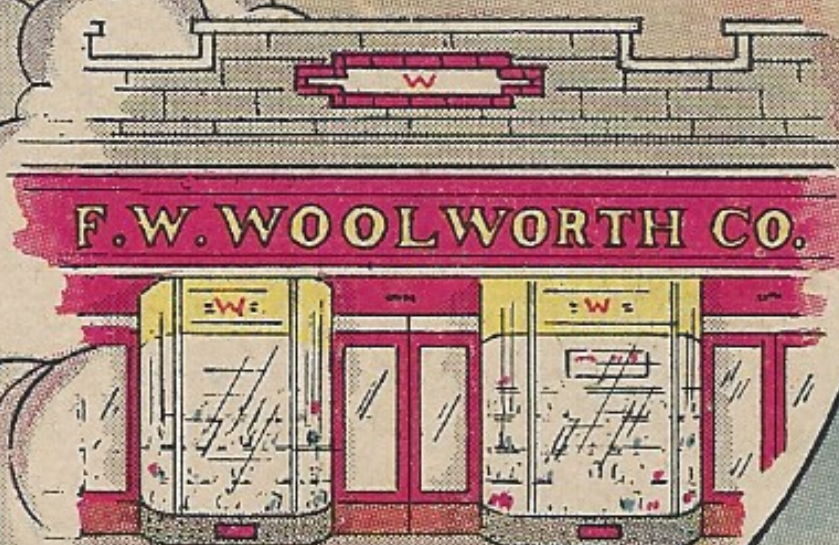
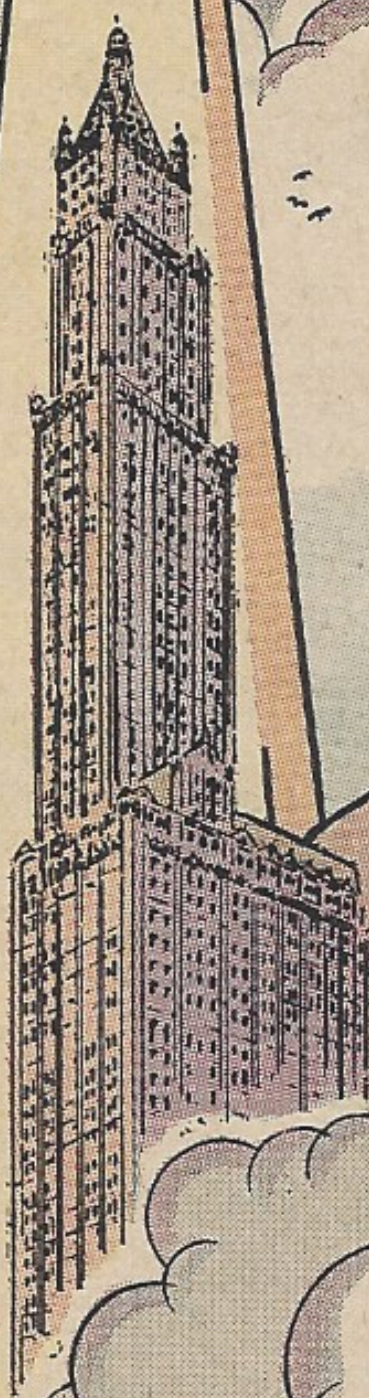

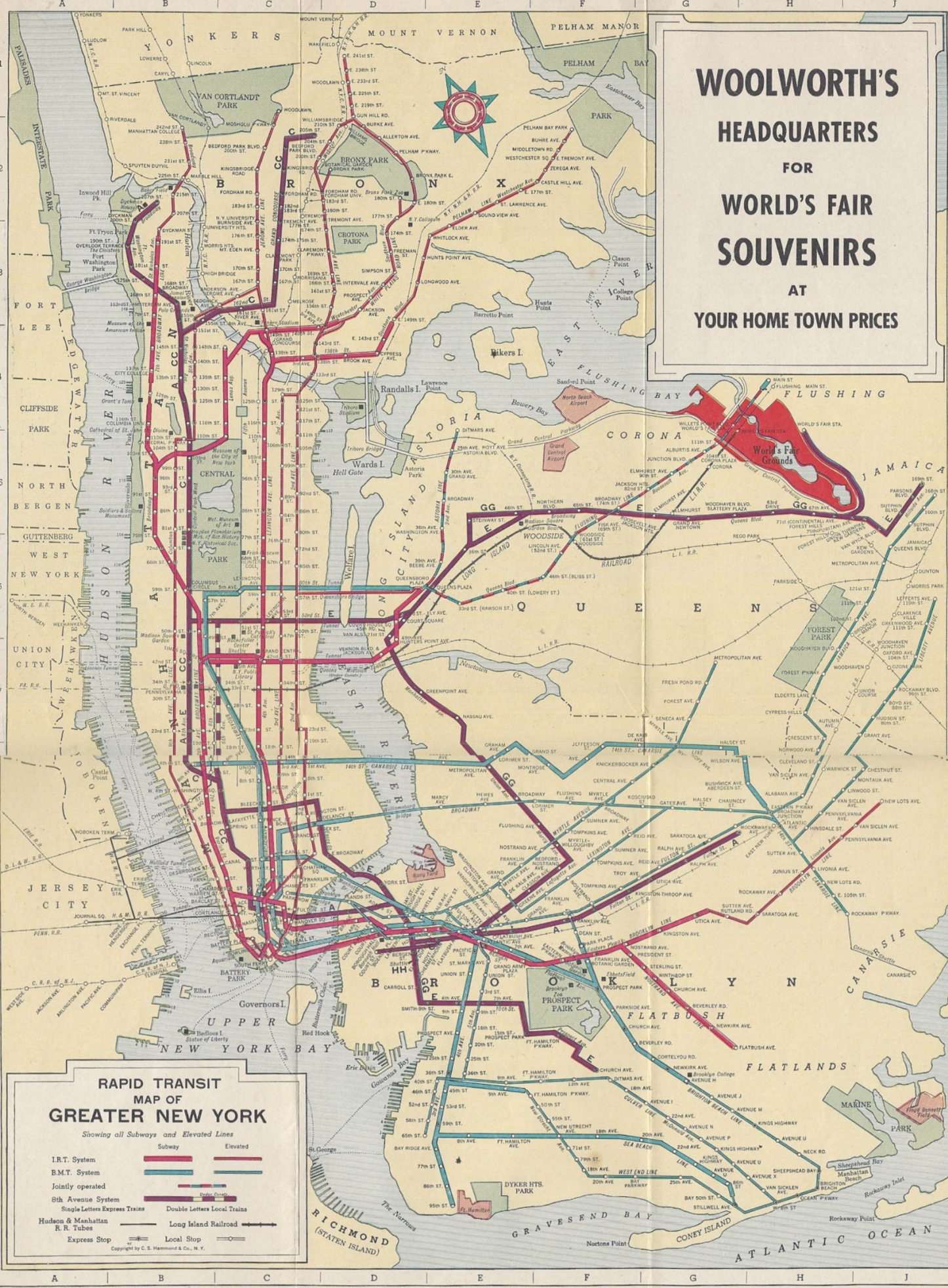
**TRANSIT MAP

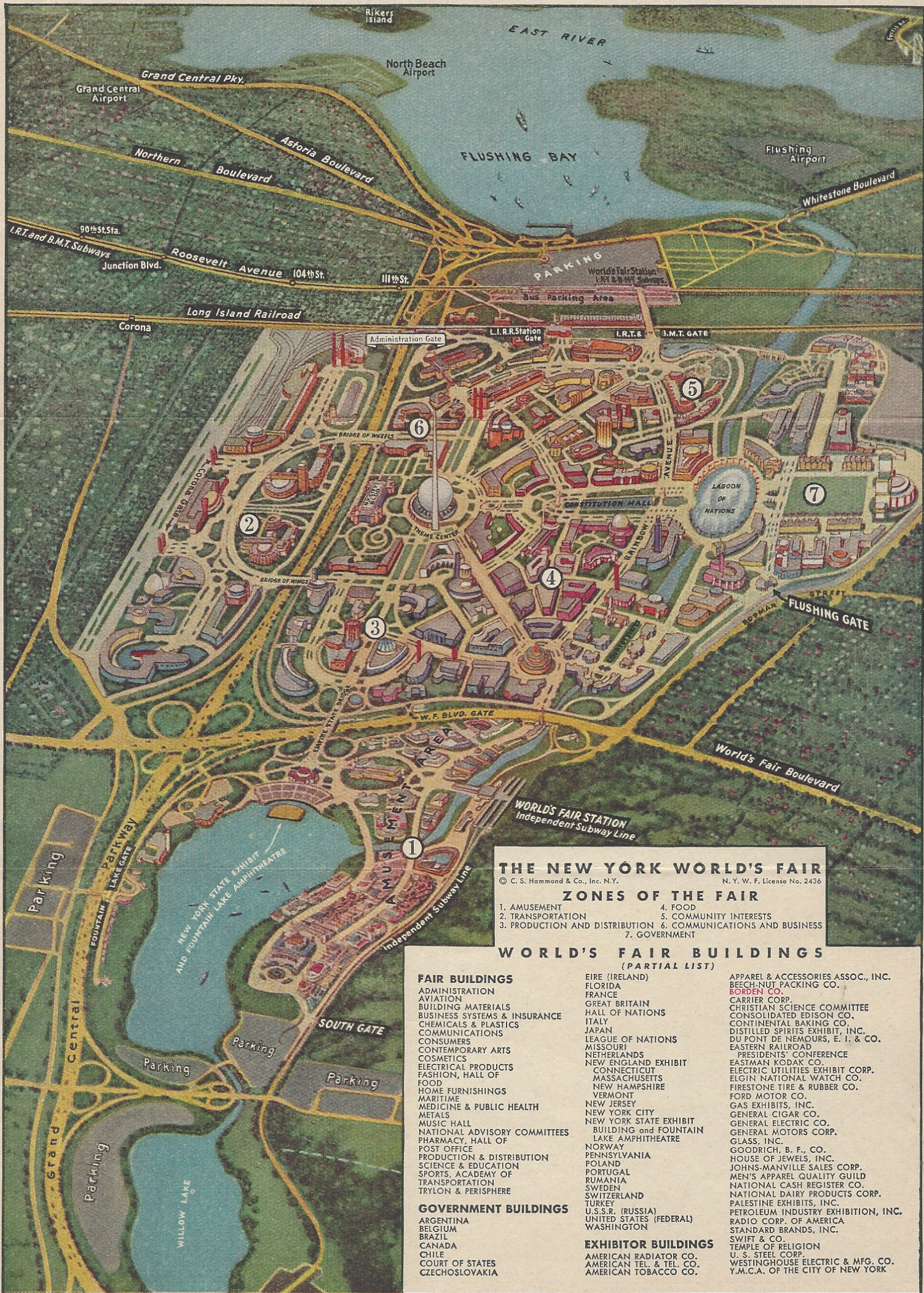

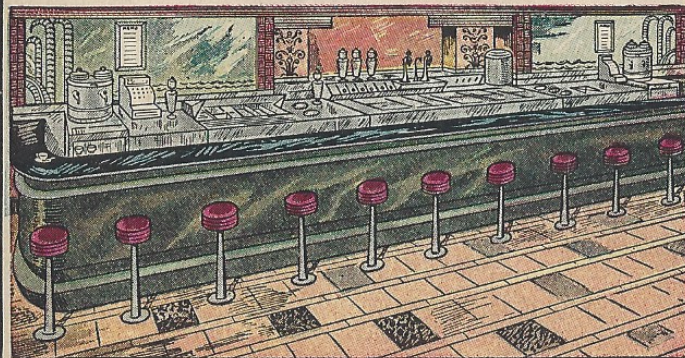
