Entertainment: Your Earth Station host or hostess can provide daily information on parades, shows, live entertainment and special events throughout the Walt Disney World Vacation Kingdom.



First Aid: A First Aid station (staffed by a Registered Nurse) is located next to the Odyssey Restaurant in Future World.

Foreign Language Assistance: Available at Guest Relations in Earth Station, adjacent to Spaceship Earth. (World Key Information Satellites also provide information in Spanish.)



For Guests with Special Needs: Wheelchairs may be rented at the base of Spaceship Earth. Restrooms and telephones are marked with this symbol. Wheelchair guests may take the monorail to the Magic Kingdom and the Polynesian Village Resort Hotel. Bus transportation to other Walt Disney World destinations can be arranged at Bus Information.



Lockers: Available at the Entrance Plaza near Spaceship Earth.

Lost & Found/Package Pick-up: Claim or report missing articles in Lost & Found at the Entrance Plaza or call 824-4245. If you wish, your day's purchases may be forwarded to Package Pick-up for your convenience.

Lost Children: Report missing children at Baby Services, adjacent to the Odyssey Restaurant in Future World.

Messages: You may leave messages for other members of your party at Earth Station.

Re-Admission: For same-day re-admission to Epcot Center or the Magic Kingdom, receive hand stamp at Exit gate before leaving. Guests with multi-day Passports should also receive a re-entry hand stamp if they plan to visit the Magic Kingdom and Epcot Center on the same day.



Restrooms: Indicated by this symbol.



Strollers: Available for rent at the Entrance Plaza (east side). Quantities limited.



Telephones: Look for this symbol.

Transportation within Epcot Center: "Friendship" launches cross the World Showcase Lagoon. Busses regularly circle the World Showcase Promenade.

Walt Disney World Reservations: For Walt Disney World overnight accommodations, dinner shows, cruises, golf or tennis, Call 824-8000.

Please note: Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times in Epcot Center and aboard all transportation vehicles.

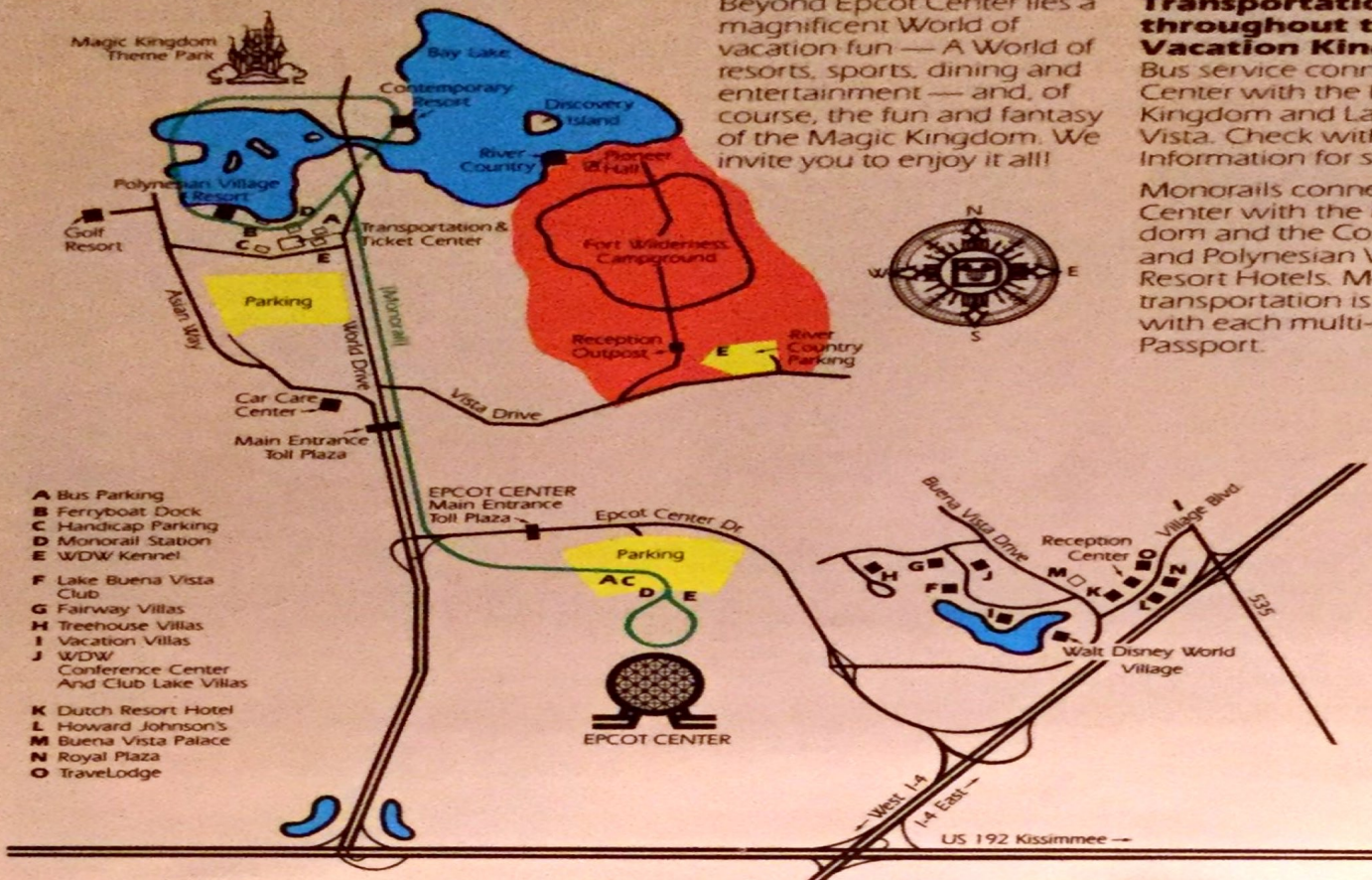
INFORMATION

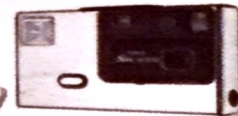
