

Re-Admission: For same-day re-admission to Epcot Center or the Magic Kingdom, receive hand stamp at Exit gate before leaving. Guests with multi-day Passports should also receive a re-entry hand stamp if they plan to visit the Magic Kingdom and Epcot Center on the same day.


